## AGENDA

- I. Approval of Minutes: Motion made by Pedigo and seconded by Williams for approval of the minutes from June 26, 2025 and May 20, 2025. Motion passed unanimously.
- II. Personnel Update: Vacancies include 18 dispatchers. A process is open now to hire 3 more supervisors and up to 6 more dispatchers.
- III. Committee Reports: None - no active committees.
- IV. Statistics: No noticeable difference in May and June. Slight decreases in CFS and 9-1-1 calls. Admin calls increased. Year over year continues to see a decrease in phone calls and an increase in CFS. The increase in CFS can be attributed to officers entering their own calls which have no associated phone call
- V. Old Business:

Stinesville Police Department IDACS update provided by Shane Pittman. Marshall Likens forwarded a report to Ryan Pedigo and the Town Board last night. There were 89 transactions, which is down by 31 in the last 6 months. All transactions have reasons they were run. Pittman asked if this could be handled outside of this board, to which Captain Pedigo advised, no, it has to be handled here. Pedito advised that all agencies are subject to the same review for compliance. Pittman advised that the officers who previously had high numbers fo inquiries are no longer with the department. They are now using spreadsheets for log inquiries for the department.
