 - BMCMPO FY2026 TIP annual allocations, programming, spending summary
 - Discussion ensued regarding the City of Bloomington's Downtown Curb Ramp not receiving its expected funding for fiscal year 2026.

 - MPO staff requested that Monroe County share any additional supporting documents, if they have it.
 - Updates on Transportation Improvement Program projects
 - MPO staff provided updates on INDOT's I-69 Bridge Deck Overlay project
 - Kopper shared updates for City of Bloomington's Downtown Curb Ramps phase 5 and High Street projects.
 - Tavernier shared updates about Monroe County's Eagleson Bridge, Rockport Bridge, Fairfax High Friction, and Old State Rd 37 S/Dillman Road projects, as well as the County's search for a new engineer.
