One Item, Ord 04-04 (Southern Indiana Medical Park II, LLC, Petitioner), on the Committee of the Whole Agenda for Wednesday, February 11th

The Council has set aside the Committee of the Whole agenda next week for a discussion of <u>Ord</u> <u>04-04</u>. This ordinance would rezone about 101 acres of land at West Tapp Road from Quarry to PUD and approve a preliminary plan that would allow a mix of office, commercial, industrial, and medical uses (including "inpatient care facilities") and would preserve approximately 64 acres of environmentally sensitive land.
