Nine Items for Special Session on Wednesday, September 10th - Two to be Postponed for Another Week

All but two of the nine items discussed at the Committee of the Whole last Wednesday are scheduled for final action at next Wednesday's Special Session. The two items not ready for final action are ordinances relating to the utility budget which should be postponed for another week. The first of these is the ordinance adjusting wastewater and storm water rates (Ord 03-24), which must be postponed because the legal ad for the hearing was sent to the H-T but not published. The second is the ordinance establishing the utility budget for 2004 (App Ord 03-08), which is being postponed so that a decision on it follows the one approving the underlying rates.

After talking with James McNamara and Chris Gaal, I am recommending that the Council hold a Committee of the Whole on September 17th after the Regular Session to discuss all the items on that cycle except the one regarding the Bryan Park Place PUD (Ord 03-26). I am also recommending that the Council hold what should be a short Special Session before the Committee of the Whole on September 24th to take final action on two of those other items (App Ord 03-09 and Ord 03-27). This schedule will set aside most of the evening of the September 24th for a discussion of the Bryan Park Place PUD and spread the other work of the Council out more evenly over those weeks.

Next week Chris should announce the Special Session on the 24th and the Council should vote on the special Committee of the Whole on the 17th.
