POLICY COMMITTEE October 13, 2017 1:30 p.m. – 3:00 p.m. Council Chambers (#115)

- I. Call to Order Introductions were made.
- II. Approval of the Minutes **** Geoff McKim moved for approval of the September 8, 2017 minutes.** Sarah Ryterband seconded the motion. The motion was approved unanimously.
- III. Communications from the Chair a. None.
- IV. Reports from Officers and/or Committees
 - a. The Citizen's Advisory Committee (CAC) met and recommended approval of the FY 2018-2021 TIP amendments were on the agenda for Policy Committee approval.
 - b. The Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) met and recommended approval of the FY 2018-2021 TIP amendments that were on the agenda for Policy Committee approval.
- V. Reports from the MPO Staff
 - *I-69 Update* Josh Desmond presented a detailed I-69 Update report including a project schedule provided by INDOT showing milestones up to October 20th. He further reported on excellent levels of technical communications between INDOT, the construction management team, and the local community.
 - b. 2040 MTP Update Desmond said that staff was making progress assembling the Draft 2040 Metropolitan Transportation Plan. The 2040 MTP must have Policy Committee adoption by the end of calendar year 2017. The last Policy Committee meeting was scheduled for November 3rd; however, the staff would require December meetings. Desmond asked all committee members to examine their schedules for availability. The BMCMPO staff conducted a final Public Information meeting in September. Meeting percipients discussed and provided feedback on the plan's vision, goals, forecast model alternatives analysis, findings, and committed projects. Mayor John Hamilton asked about the frequency of long range plan updates. Desmond replied every five years. Geoff McKim asked if modeling data would be incorporated into the 2040 MTP. Desmond replied yes.
 - c. *Safety Performance Measure Crash Data Analysis –* Desmond said that staff would be developing performance measures to establish and track transportation system safety performance.

INDOT must soon adopt safety performance measure goals aimed at reducing crashes. Indiana MPOs would then have to option to either agree with the state's established safety performance goals or devise independent goals based on INDOT rigorous statistically measurable crash rates, such as, fatalities and serious injuries per 100 million vehicular miles. Mayor John Hamilton said that it was very important to know what is being measured noting that Bloomington's goal of more people walking and biking would change the metrics. Geoff McKim questioned additional details regarding the data, assumptions, and goal metrics. Desmond promised additional future information.

- d. BMCMPO Staffing Update Desmond said that he would be taking a leave of absence starting October 27th to be with his new son and return on January 10th. Pat Martin and Scott Robinson would provide BMCMPO staff support during this time. Beginning in January 2018, he would become the Planning and Transportation Deputy Director and oversee the Planning and Development Divisions. Pat Martin would remain as the MPO coordinator. An additional full-time MPO planner position will be advertised and hired after January 1st to expand upon the BMCMPO service needs. Geoff McKim thanked and congratulated the staff.

- VII. New Business
 - a. FY 2018-2021 TIP Amendments* Desmond presented two FY2018-2021 TIP amendments requested by INDOT. The amendments were either district-wide or state-wide projects. They included:
 - (1) SR446 at Lampkins Ridge Road Construction Phase Safety Funding (DES#1700317) will fund construction of un-signalized intersection sign and visibility marking safety improvements Construction in FY2020 at the intersection of SR446 with Lampkins Ridge Road and various locations in the Seymour District. The programmed cost is \$300,000 with no matching funds requirement.
 - (2) SR46/SR45 at SR45/10th Street Construction Phase Safety Funding (#1702224) will fund construction of traffic signal visibility improvements at the intersection of SR46/SR45 at SR45/10th Street and at various locations throughout the state in FY2020 with programmed cost of \$889,200 and matching state funds of \$88,800. Both FY2018-2021 TIP Amendments were recommended for approval by the BMCMPO CAC and TAC. **** Sarah Ryterband moved for approval of the FY 2018-2021 TIP Amendments. Geoff McKim seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously approved.**

• MOT DISCUSSIONS

- INDOT and City discussed Cota Drive's paving schedule and drawings for the County to review. Would like to know how cul-de-sacs will be handled
- Maple Grove Road: The city has requested INDOT to review this road. INDOT stated potentially putting in a right-of-way fence as long as it does not land lock anyone
- INDOT closed Chambers Pike, rerouting traffic to Sparks Lane (which was paved)
 - Crossover Road on west side will be closed at south end, accessible from the north
 - Should be completed by mid-October
- Work in Zone 3 (Sample Road to the north) such as Bifurcated area, Liberty Church interchange still on track to be done Dec. 1
 - Access roads to the west of Liberty Church interchange to be completed by Dec.
- Single lane restrictions north of Sample are to still be in place by Dec. 1
- Leonard Springs signage stating Fullerton is still closed is still up. Needs to be taken down
- City requested review of 2nd St. SB exit ramp is difficult to see, has a narrow exit and uneven pavement. INDOT proposed reviewing to make it more visible while overnight paving
- INDOT has been taking down temporary signage that's no longer need. Please let INDOT know of any other temporary signage that's no longer needed in certain areas
 - County says there's still Sec. 4 signage up near Rockport Rd.
- CBU needs contract amendment due to two design changes at Ryan property and Wylie and Ellis roads
- INDOT is putting together a preliminary punch list for Kinser Pike, Fullerton Pike and Rockport Road

The MPO conducted its latest Quarterly Project Tracking meeting for programmed Transportation Improvement program projects on October 11, 2017 (see attachment). All projects continue moving forward on their scheduled timelines with a few projects of significant note listed below.

Key Changes/Milestones:

- Fullerton Pike Phase I Clearing operations are complete; utility relocations continue, and construction will proceed once the overhead utilities are relocated & existing overhead electric poles are removed.
- Fullerton Pike Phase II Right-of-way acquisition continues with the completion of appraisals for eleven (11) parcels.
- Tapp Road & Rockport Road Intersection Improvement INDOT approved pavement design on March 30, 2017. RIght-of-way is secured for ten (10) of twelve (12) parcels. Right-of-way clearing date is October 13, 2017.

The next Quarterly Project Tracking meeting is scheduled for January 2018.
