#### **AGENDA**

- I. <u>Approval of Minutes:</u> Russell Brummett made a motion for approval of the May 16 and June 26, 2018 minutes. Mike Cornman seconded the motion. Unanimously approved.

#### V. Old Business:

• *Locution:* Still in the testing phase. Overall Jeff is impressed with it. City Fire plans to start testing it the week of July 23<sup>rd</sup>. The hold up with them testing it out is because fiber optic lines have not been installed.

Jeff has noticed that Locution finishes about 95% of the fire dispatches before the dispatcher.

Training for the dispatchers has not been scheduled, yet. CAD/RMS Administrator Eli Eccles has to have approximately six hours of training for the CAD side of Locution. That has not been scheduled yet either.

- *Pulse Point:* The soft launch will happen around the beginning of August. Hope to be up and running by mid-August. Testing has been going great. AED registration is the only part that needs some work.
- VI. <u>New Business:</u>
  - *Claims:* Mike Cornman made a motion to approve the City & County claims. Russell Brummett seconded the motion. Unanimously approved.
