Discussion: number of accidents; sight distance; vehicle counts; possible queuing at the intersection; lane markings needed; advance warning sign for eastbound; location of stop signs; west side of the railroad tracks will be no changes;

Was a roundabout considered? Yes, but no funding for it at this time. Challenges with improving the pedestrian crossing at this locations. Noted to consider flagging at the intersection to not the changes both immediately and in the fall when school resumes.
