Proposed Amendment:

1. Ordinance 19-13 shall be amended by inserting a new Section 1 which shall read as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 15.37.020 entitled “Applicability” shall be amended by inserting a row in the table that describes the scope of the Garden Hill Residential Neighborhood Zone (Zone 6) to add West 17th Street, which shall read as follows:

Garden Hill Residential Neighborhood Zone (Zone 6) – *New Row:*

Street	From	To	Side of Street
East 17th	North Walnut	North Dunn Street	South

2. Ordinance 19-13 shall be further amended by renumbering subsequent sections.
3. Ordinance 19-13 shall be further amended by deleting the word “Resolved” as it appears in the enacting clause and replacing that word with “ordained” so that the enacting clause reads as follows:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, MONROE COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT:

4. Ordinance 19-13 shall be further amended by adding Section 15.37.020 (Applicability) to the subtitle of the ordinance so that the title and subtitle now read:

TO AMEND TITLE 15 OF THE BLOOMINGTON MUNICIPAL CODE ENTITLED “VEHICLES & TRAFFIC”

Re: Amending Sections 15.32.080 (No Parking Zones) and 15.37.020 (Applicability [of Residential Neighborhood Permit Parking Zones])




