Service, Porter, Regester, Olcott, MayerROLL CALL Roll Call: Gross, Murphy, Foley, Young. AGENDA SUMMATION President Mayer gave the Agenda summation. Young announced the upcoming Festival of Trees to MESSAGES FROM be held at the Monroe County Courthouse this up-COUNCI LMEMBERS coming weekend to benefit the Bloomington Hospital LEGISLATION FOR Olcott moved and Foley seconded the motion that Ordinance 87-56 be introduced and read by title onlyFIRST READING/VOTE Clerk Williams read the ordinance. Olcott moved and Foley seconded the motion that ORDINANCE 87-56 Ordinance 87-56 be adopted. The ordinance received a roll call vote of Ayes:9, Nays:0. Olcott moved and Foley seconded the motion that APP. ORD. 87-12 Appropriation Ordinance 87-12 be introduced and read by title only. Clerk Williams read the ordinace. Olcott moved and Foley seconded the motion that Appropriaton Ordinance 87-12 be adopted. Betty Merriman was present for questions and the ordinance received a roll call vote of Ayes;9, Nays:0 Olcott moved and Foley seconded the motion that ORDINANCE 87-57 Ordinance 87-57 be introduced and read by title Clerk Williams read the ordinance. only. Olcott moved and Foley seconded the motion that 87-57 be adopted. Ordinance Tim Mueller gave a brief description of the tract noting that the vacation would provide for three additional units making a total of 10. In reviewing the criteria for vaction there was one objection; while the petitioner is making good use of the alley as access to other parking areas, without the vacation there would be no access at all for other ajacent property owners. The petitioner said he would allow easements for public use and that seems to be something of a contradiction. Mueller said that in general neighborhodd response has been negative to this type of development. All units would be 5 bedroom units and there is concern that the 3½ spaces allocated for parking would be insufficient for a 5 bedroom unit. The law regarding RH does not differentiate between 2,3, or 5 bedroom units. The staff recommends denial and questions whether or not we want to encourage this type of develop-If the vacation is denied then the developer ment. would build 7 units .. Terry Elkins, the petitioner, said that they meet all the requirements for vacation and that they would pave the alley all the way to Dunn St. The alley would remain open for traffic and access to ajacent parking areas.

Don Capp, a nearby property owner, objected to the plan saying that he had not had an opportunity to review the ordinances, that he had not been notified, and that there is already a "terrible parking problem with there own rentals" and that additional units would only add to the problem.

Olcott moved that the ordinance be tabled for two weeks until the questions could be worked out with Mr. Capp.

The motion to table Ordinance 87-57 received a roll call vote of Ayes: 7, Nays:2 (Young, Porter).

It was moved and seconded that the following ordinance be introduced and read by title only for first reading by the Clerk. Clerk Williams read the ordinance before the Common Council.
