In the Common Council Chambers of the Municipal Building held COMMON COUNCIL on October 20, 1982, with Council President Pat Murphy presiding OCTOBER 20, 1982 REGULAR SESSION over a regular session of the Common Council. Councièmembers present: Towell, Porter, Allison, Murphy, Dilcher, Olcott, Service, Hogan. Absent: Morrison. ROLL CALL Service announced the Town Theatre's upcoming production MESSAGES FROM of The Mikado and urged the community to be aware of local COUNCILMEMBERS productions of this type. Murphy announced current vacancies on three city boards and commissions: Animal Control, Human Resources, and Human Rights. The deadline for applications is October 25, 1982. MAYORAL MESSAGE There was no Mayoral message. PETITIONS AND There were no Petitions or Communications. COMMUNICATIONS Murphy moved and Service seconded a motion to consider Appropriation Ordinance 82-13 first on the agenda. The motion carried by a voice vote. Olcott moved and Towell seconded a motion to introduce and SECOND READINGS: read Appropriation Ordinance 82-13 by title only. APP. ORD. 82-13 FEDERAL REVENUE Clerk Williams read the appropriation ordinance by title only. SHARING (PSI) Olcott moved and Towell seconded a motion to adopt Appropriation Ordinance 82-13. Dilcher read the legislative synopsis. Hogan said that enough funds were appropriated for legal services for this municipality and that he would vote no on this appropriation. Appropriation Ordinance was adopted by a roll call vote of Ayes: 6, Nays: 2 (Olcott and Hogan). Olcott moved and Towell seconded a motion to introduce and APP. ORD. 82-15 read Appropriation Ordinance 82-15 by title only. APP. FROM THE MOTOR VEHICLE HWY. FUND Clerk Williams read the appropriation ordinance by title only. FOR A HYDRAULIC LIFT Olcott moved and Towell seconded a motion to adopt Appropriation Ordinance 82-15. Dilcher read the legislative synopsis. Councilmember Service left the meeting. John Freeman said that the spreader boxes were used to spread salt and sand. Appropriation Ordinance 82-15 received a roll call vote of Ayes: 7, Nays: 0. Olcott moved and Towell seconded a motion to introduce and ORD, 82-66. read Ordinance 82-66 by title only. TRANSFER APP. WITHIN

Clerk Williams read the ordinance by title only.

Olcott moved and Towell seconded a motion to adopt Ordinance 82-66.

Dilcher read the legislative synopsis.

Frank Ragan explained the purpose of the transfer stating the need for a shelter of this type. He said that the purchased shelter house was actually cheaper than something that Parks and Recreation could construct themselves and would be a necessary item in this area. Boat rental and the sale of safe, environmentally controlled bait would be the type of items available at the concession area of the shelter, not food or drink items.

The ordinance received a roll call vote of Ayes; 7, Nays: 0.

The following ordinance was introduced and read for first reading by title only by Clerk Williams and the legislative synopsis by Councilmember Dilcher.
