In the Common Council Chambers of the Municipal Building held on June 5, 1980, with Councilmember Katherine Dilcher presiding over a regular session of the Common Council.

Councilmembers present: Olcott, Morrison, Murphy, Porter, Hogan, Dilcher and Service. Councilmembers absent: Towell and Allison (both out of town).

Dilcher noted that Ordinance 80-49, K-Mart rezoning, has been removed from the agenda at the request of the petitioner's. attorney. It will beceive second reading at the June 19 meeting. Murphy had several messages. (1) He said he is sympathetic to dog owners, but he has noticed that now that summertime is here, there are quite a few dogs running without leashes. He asked people to be considerate and keep their dogs on a leash. (2) Many people are improving their properties, but he said many people are not cutting their grass or doing other routine property maintenance. (3) He commended Roger Branam and his street crews and for the excellent job they are doing on building new streets and sidewalks. (4) He was extremely pleased with the new transit proposal presented by Mr. Martindale to the Board of Works. He said he hopes the Council will approve the proposals for expanded routes.

Olcott said he agreed that the transit study was excellent. He noted that Bloomington Transit was a campaign issue in 1979 because some felt it was not being run professionally, but it is good to see that new routes will be tried and professionals consulted on other possible improvements. He said that he hopes their recommendations will be implemented.

Service said she is pleased to see new curbs being built in her district. Also, she commended the Fire Department for their hasty response to a serious gasoline spill at Eighth and Walnut last week.

There was no message from the Mayor.

There were no petitions or communications.

Olcott moved and Morrison seconded a motion to introduce and read Ordinance 80-46 by title only.
