Monday, August 30, 1954

The Common Council of the City of Bloomington met in a Special Statutory Session in the City Hall, Bloomington, Indiana, August 30, 1954, at the hour of 7:30 o'clock P.M. with Mayor Kelly presiding.

The Clerk-Treasurer had duly notified in writing each member of the Council and has in her file a signed receipt from each Council member for the notice.

Members Present: Donham, Griffith, McDaniel, Miller, Porter, and Ramsey

Members Absent: Carpenter

Mayor Kelly stated that this Statutory Meeting was for the purpose of taking final action on the appropriations in the Budget for the year 1955, and the amount of appropriation for each Department was read to the Council totaling 470,389.90 for the General Fund and \$428,114.52 for the Special Funds with the combined total of \$898,504.42.

Appropriation Ordinance for these funds was presented to the Council and on motion of Councilman Griffith, seconded by Councilman Porter, on a roll-call vote, passed unanimously to second reading. Mayor Kelly then asked if there were any questions or objections concerning the Budget from those present. There being none, Councilman McDaniel, seconded by Councilman Miller, moved the adoption of the Appropriation Ordinance as read. On a roll-call vote, the motion passed unanimously and Appropriation Ordinance No. 3, 1954, was declared duly passed and adopted. On motion duly made and seconded, the meeting adjourned.
