THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA, met in a special statuatory session at the City Hall, Bloomington, Indiana, August 25, 1952, at the hour of six-thirty (6:30) P.M., with Mayor Kelly presiding.

Members present: Fowler, Griffith, McDaniel, Miller, and Ramsey and the Members absent: Carpenter and Porter

Councilman Miller moved the Council dispense with the reading of minutes of the last meeting until the next regular meeting; Councilman McDaniel seconded the motion; motion carried.

Mayor Kelly stated that this statuatory meeting was for the purpose of acting on the appropriations for the Budget for 1953, and read comparative figures on the proposed budget for the various departments.

After discussion of the budgets, Appropriation Ordinance No. 1, 1952, based on the amended budgets, was presented to the Council. Councilman Fowler moved for suspension of the rules so that the Council might vote on adoption of the budget at this meeting. Councilman McDaniel seconded the motion; motion carried.

Councilman Fowler moved that Appropriation Ordinance No. 1, 1952, be adopted; Councilman Griffith seconded the motion; Mayor Kelly requested a roll call vote, and the response was as follows: Ayes: Fowler, Griffith, McDaniel, Miller, and Ramsey; Nays: none; Absent: Carpenter and Porter; motion carried.

Ordinance No. 7, 1952, adopting the Federal Social Security plan for the employees of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, with the exception of the elected officials, was presented to the Council. Councilman Fowler moved that the rules be suspended so that the Ordinance might be voted on at this meeting; Councilman Miller seconded the motion; motion carried. Councilman Griffith moved adoption of the Ordinance as read; Councilman Miller seconded the motion; after considerable discussion, Mayor Kelly requested a roll call vote, and the response was as follows: Ayes: Fowler, Griffith, McDaniel, Miller; Nays: Ramsey; absent: Carpenter and Porter; motion carried.

On motion of Councilman Miller, seconded by Councilman McDaniel, the meeting adjourned.
