## REGULAR COUNCIL

## Tuesday, December 2, 1952

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA, met in regular session in the Council Chamber at the hour of seven-thirty P.M. (7:30 P.M.), on Tuesday, December 2, 1952, with Mayor Kelly presiding.

Members present: Carpenter, Fowler, Griffith, McDaniel, Miller, Porter, and Ramsey

Members absent: none

The minutes of the last regular meeting were approved on motion of Councilman Miller, seconded by Councilman McDaniel.

James R. Regester, attorney for Sarkes Tarzian, Inc., addressed the Council concerning the suit filed by Sarkes Tarzian, Inc., against the City of Bloomington, to close that portion of an non-platted alley which runs east and west from College Avenue and Norton Street between Eighth and Ninth Streets. After discussion and consideration of those persons affected, Councilman Carpenter moved that the City Attorney be instructed by the Council not to contest the suit. Councilman Fowler seconded the motion, and the motion pass<sup>eq</sup> unanimously by a roll call vote.

The report for the month of November 1952 presented by L. M. Rogers, Superintendent of the Sanitation Department, was accepted by the Council on motion of Councilman Fowler, seconded by Councilman Porter.

J. N. Gilmore, Street Commissioner, presented the report of the Street Department for the month of November 1952, which was accepted on motion of Councilman McDaniel, seconded by Councilman Miller.

The report of Horace Robertson, Fire Chief, for the Fire Department for the month of November 1952, was accepted by the Council on motion of Councilman Fowler, seconded by Councilman Carpenter.

As Chairman of the Committee appointed by the Mayor to investigate conditions at the filling station at 1023 South Walnut Street, Mr. Fowler reported that the Committee had met with the owner of the property and also the operator of the filling station, and have been assured of their cooperation in the improvement of sanitary facilities, and abatement of nuisance of noise, etc. At the suggestion of Mayor Kelly, in view of this report, the Council decided to withhold any further action until a later date.

The meeting adjourned on motion of Councilman Carpenter, seconded by Councilman McDaniel.
