Councilwoman Woolery moved Eugene Bender be reappointed for a four year term on the Park Board, seconded by Councilman Chitwood. Upon a roll call vote, the vote was unanimous in favor of his reappointment.

The Mayor read a letter to the Council from the owners of the tract of land under discussion for a City Park, said owners rejecting the three proposals presented to them by the Council, and stated the City has to buy all the land or none.

Councilwoman Woolery moved the Council postpone action on the park site proposal until its next meeting on December 29, 1950. Motion seconded by Councilman Dunn and carried.
