-Plan to elect a new president, recruit new members, purpose/role BCCAC

-Becky explains role: goal to get input for a certain area (Banneker); advice/tips/help; not a policy-making council

-Erik addresses administrative role: reach out via e-mail with interest, address at June meeting

-Amy: City Commission involvement recognizes that not everyone will agree; end of the day it is our mission to help and support the families and kids who use this Center (we are straying away from this); hope to move forward from this

-Response: Does not see the mission as a problem

-Response: Nichelle still committed to serving community; reconsider diversifying Center's leadership
