\* This meeting will commence after the Council concludes a Special Session that evening, but no sooner than 8:00 p.m. The Special Session will be held in the Council Chambers (Room 115) beginning at 6:00 p.m. If the Redistricting meeting has not begun at 8:00 p.m., please approach the desk at the south side of the Council Chambers to determine when it will begin.

The Council Redistricting Committee has been created by Council President Mayer and consists of the three at-large members of the Council: Mayer, Ruff, and Sandberg. Its charge is to propose new district maps for consideration by the City Council before the end of this year as required by I.C. 36-4-6-3. Please note that maps and census data are available for public inspection in the Office of City Clerk/Council.

Because a quorum of the Council may be present, this meeting may constitute a meeting of the Council as well as of the Redistricting Committee under the Indiana Open Door Law.
