## **BLOOMINGTON BOARD OF PUBLIC SAFETY**

The Bloomington Board of Public Safety held a Regular Session on **Tuesday, March 22, 2022, at 6:00 p.m.**, in person in the City of Bloomington McCloskey Conference Room located at 401 N. Morton Street, Bloomington, Indiana.

### **CALL TO ORDER**

Board President Kim Gray called the meeting to order at approximately 6:00 p.m. Board members Luis Fuentes-Rohwer and Shruti Rana were present.

Board members Maqubé Reese was not present.

### **APPROVAL OF PREVIOUS MEETING MINUTES**

Board member Luis Fuentes-Rohwer moved to approve the meeting minutes from February 15, 2022. Board member Shruti Rana seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously, 3-0.

### **POLICE DEPARTMENT BUSINESS**

#### **Report on Monthly Statistics, Training and Incident Reports:**

Deputy Police Chief Joe Qualters presented the monthly statistics and training.

#### **General Business:**

Deputy Police Chief Joe Qualters provided an update.

#### **Purchases: Expenditures/Procurements:**

Deputy Police Chief Joe Qualters said there will be some expenditures for body cams.

#### **Personnel:**

Deputy Police Chief Joe Qualters and Captain Ryan Pedigo provided an update, noting that they are short staffed. Captain Ryan Pedigo said there is a wait for the Indiana Law Enforcement Academy and that if he hired an officer today, they would not be able to attend the academy until January of 2023.

Board member Luis Fuentes-Rohwer inquired about what low staffing means for the department. Deputy Police Chief Joe Qualters and Captain Ryan Pedigo both answered that question.

Board member Kim Gray inquired about the morale as a result of low staffing and about salary increases. She then asked about a partnership with IUPD during Little 500. Deputy Police Chief Joe Qualters answered the questions in turn.

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Board member Luis Fuentes-Rohwer then inquired as to whether shortages are nation and state wide, and Deputy Police Chief Joe Qualters answered the question.

Letters of Appreciation and Commendation:

Deputy Police Chief Joe Qualters said there were two in the packet and provided details.

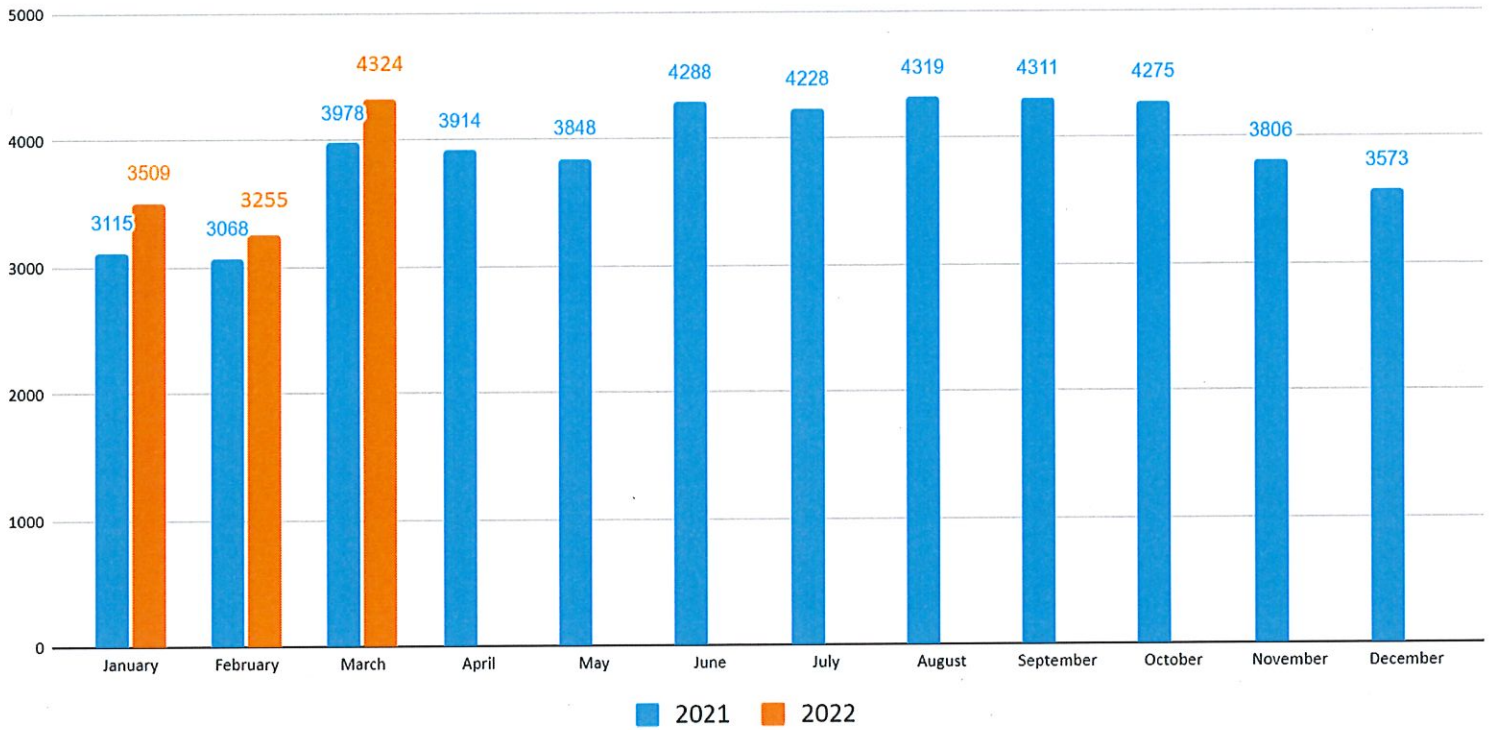

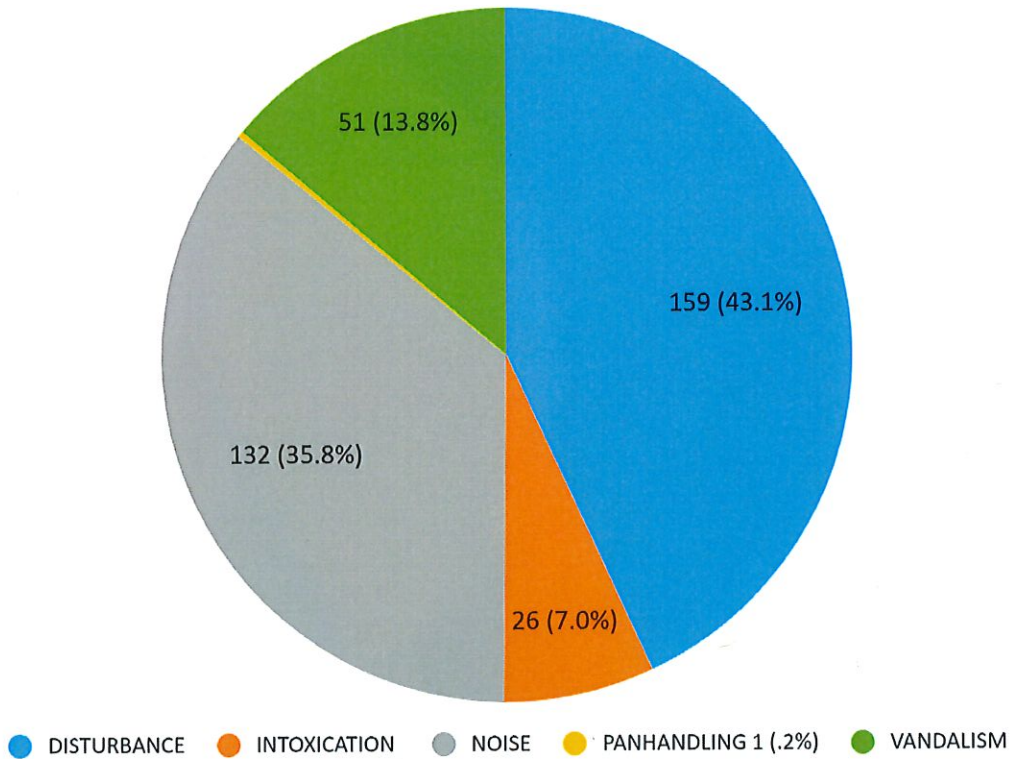




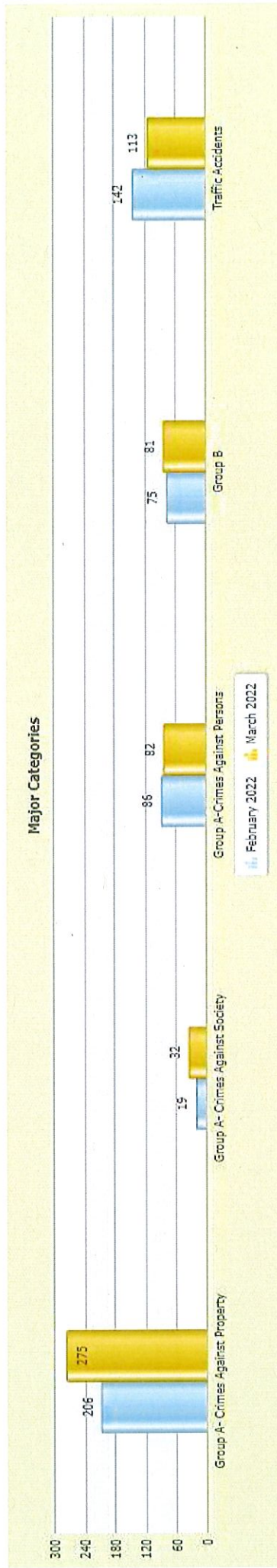
### 2021-2022 Calls For Service Totals



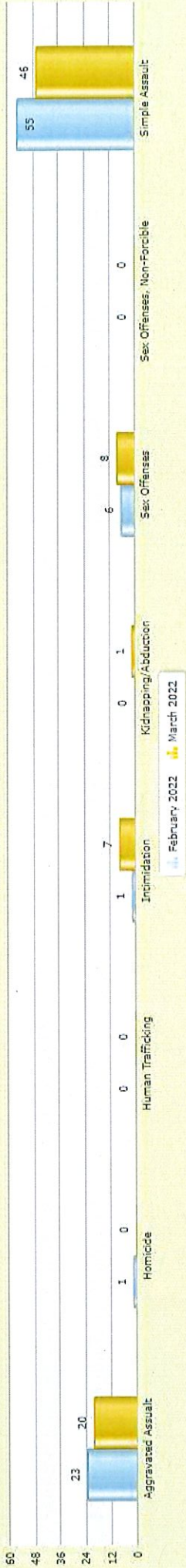
### March 2022 Nuisance Calls for Service

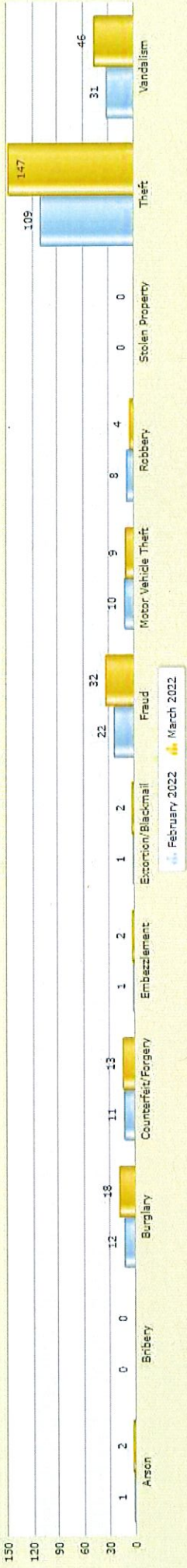

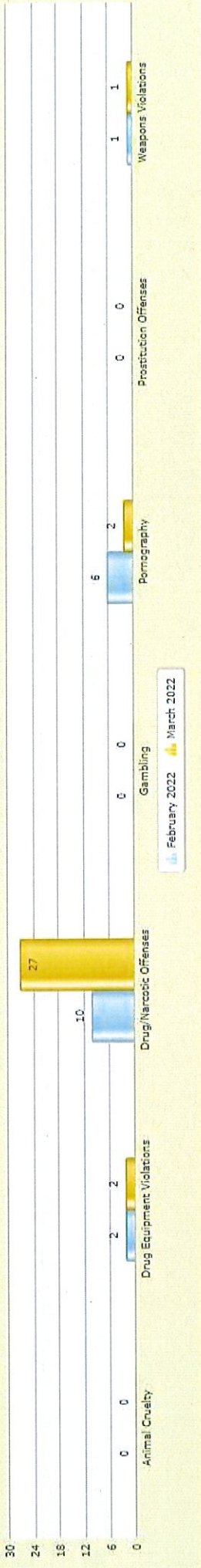

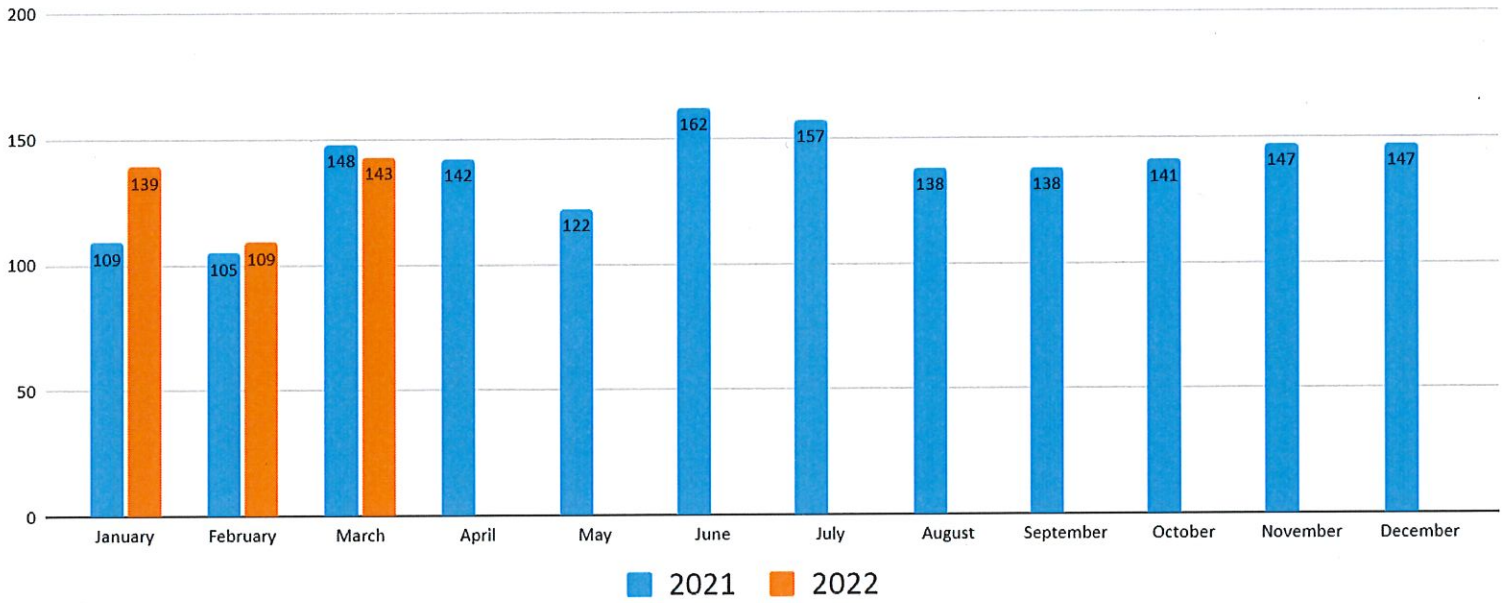

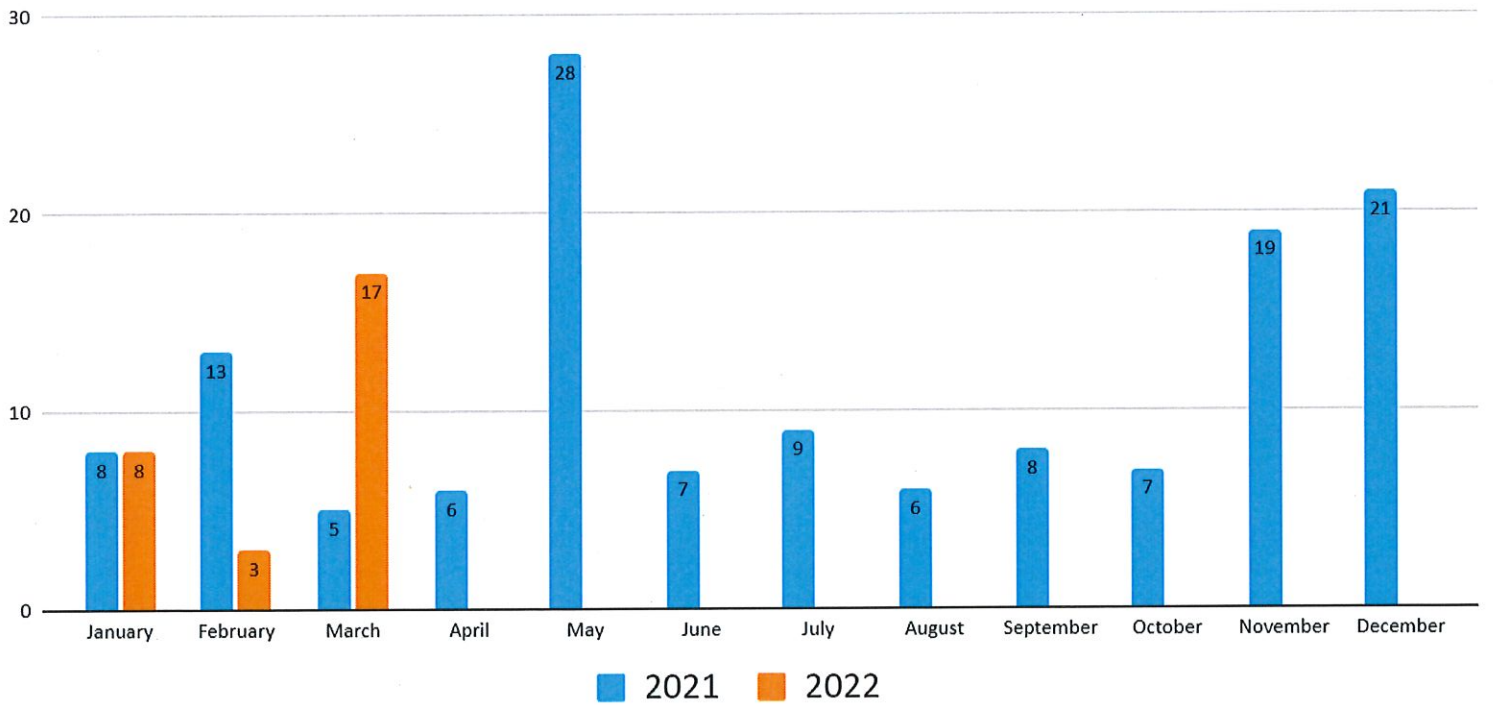

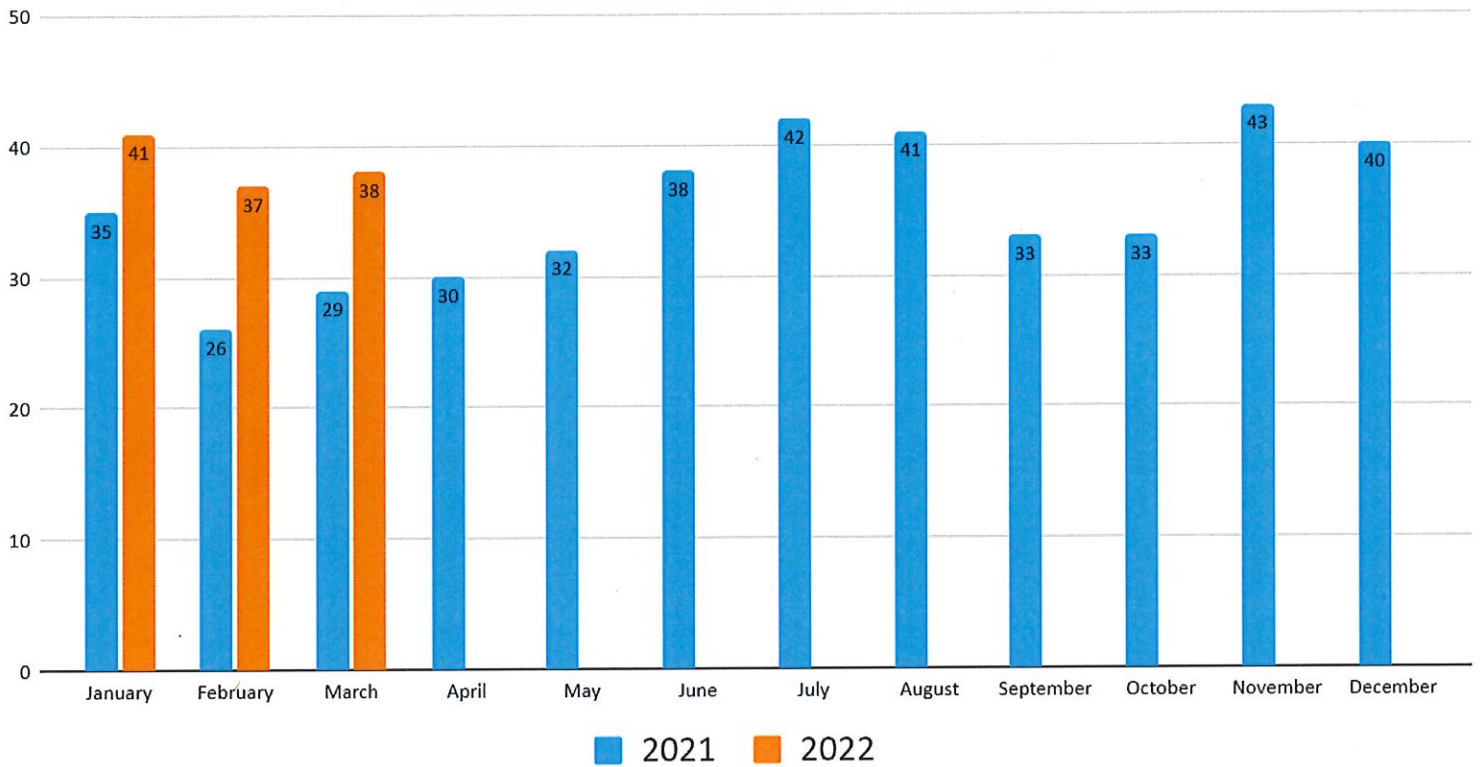
### 2021-2022 Adult Arrests

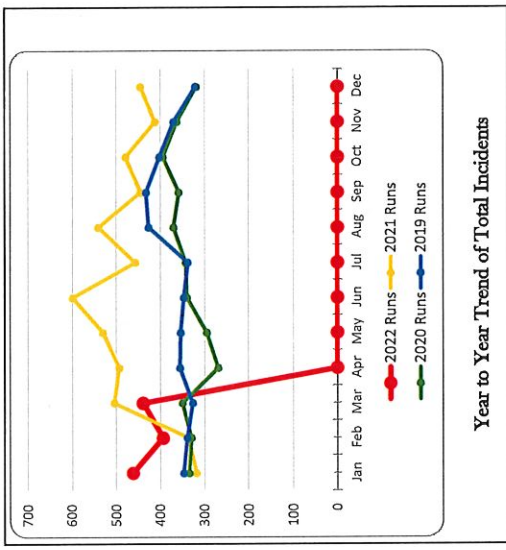
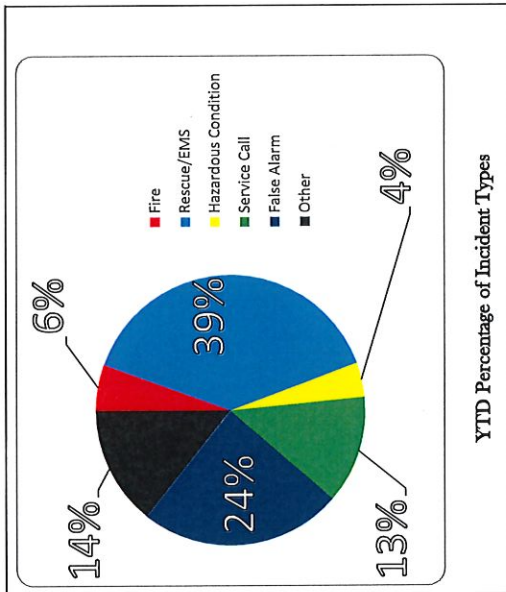

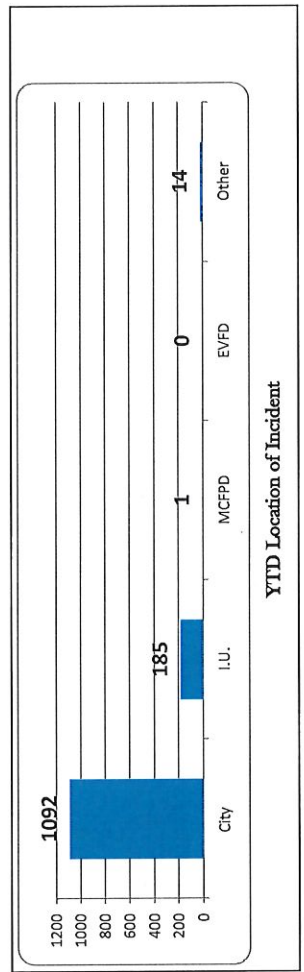

## Operational Statistics



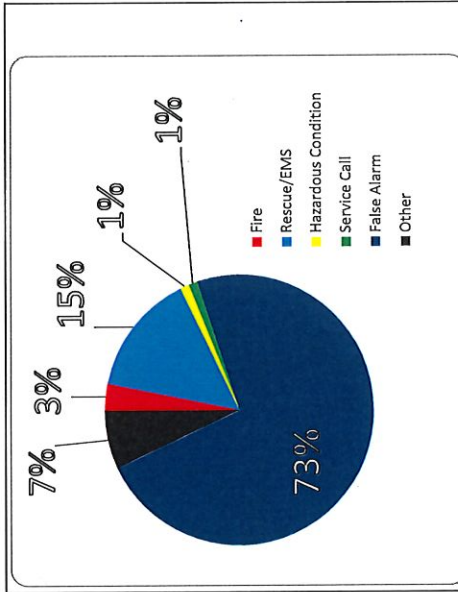
YTD Percentage of Incident Types

Year to Year Trend of Total Incidents

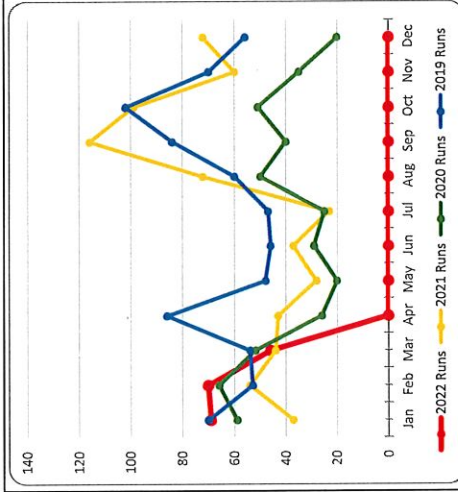


YTD Location of Incident

YTD Percentage of Incident Types (IU)



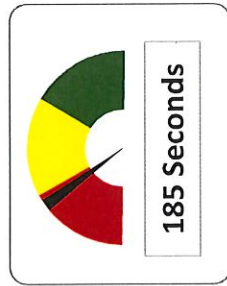
Year to Year Trend of Total Incidents (IU)

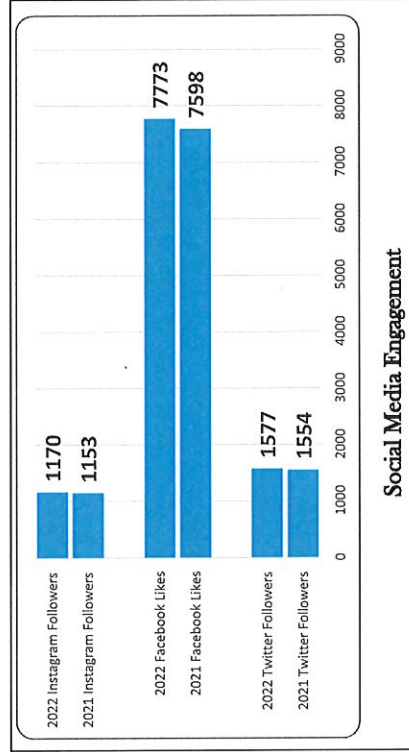

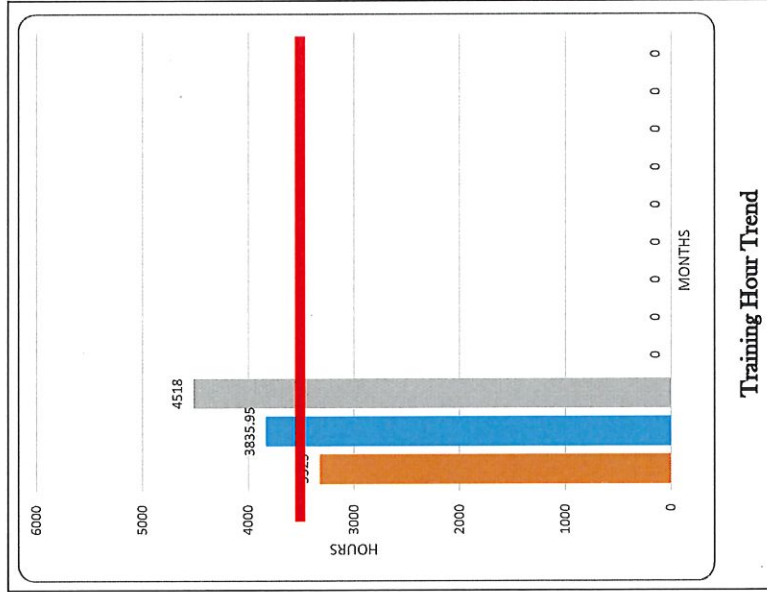

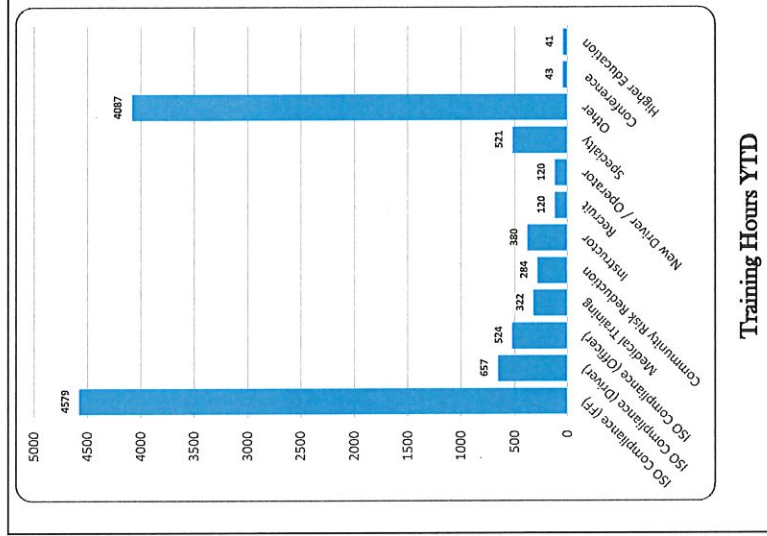
