- 5. Urban Forester's Report and Tree Commission Education (Haskell Smith) -
- May be some changes to next month's meeting format due to Open Door policies
- Downtown development removals started- 90 trees being replaced or new additions
- Pruned in Stone Mill/RCA
- Still gearing up for spring planting
- Park Board- service agreement with Mother Nature Landscaping (disease treatment), ash tree
  removal, EAB treatment, IU survey (if too late will be postponed to next month), Tree City
  approved (39 years)- sign up, IDEM permit for green waste- Haskell applied, arbor day set for
  4/28 (6 trees to plant, TC members can attend), UF booth at Saturday Farmers' Market every 4<sup>th</sup>

Saturday (TC members can help), Duke MOU for next round, replacements in 2024, 1<sup>st</sup> phase of Callery Pear removals approved (14 trees in street and 16 in parks), 3/25 working with Community Orchard for pruning workshop, Haskell has put together educational materials (TC members can help)- Haskell can send to TC, ongoing volunteer tree planting project at RCA with IU affiliate- 80+ volunteers 4/29, Tree Manual updates. Garden Show prep, golf course project

No issues, today at landscape architecture staff meeting, tree inventory data for all 7 campuses will be presented, Mia will ask about links/interface with city- inventory will be electronically available, working with Sarah Mincey to make data available for students to analyze, have already computed ecosystem services, canopy, species diversity, inventory will be launching point of Woodland Campus Initiative

7. Report from Environmental Commission (Dave Parkhurst)

Busy meeting last week with several new members, looked at proposals/updates to UDO and got responses from city, outreach working group- tabling at Garden Fair, working with Eco Heroes- for art related to tree ecosystem services, reorganization of working groups- EC Planning Committee (used to have connection with Linda Thompson to review plans) -trying to learn how to access these plans that do not meet UDO criteria, biodiversity group- working with Habitat Connectivity Plan
