**Proposed Amendment:**

1. Ordinance 23-12, Section 1 shall be amended by reducing the number of Community EMT / Community Paramedic positions listed within the Fire Department to (4).

**Synopsis**

This amendment is sponsored by Cm. Piedmont-Smith and would delete the proposed increase in the number of Community EMT / Community Paramedic positions within the Fire Department. There are currently 4 such positions, and the ordinance would add 3 more. This amendment deletes that change to the salary ordinance. After discussion with Chief Moore and feedback from firefighters, it was determined that the City should not take on the \$243,432 annual fiscal impact of the additional 3 EMTs at this time.

**Proposed Amendment:**

1. Ordinance 23-13 shall be amended by striking the words “to add a new position in the Fire Department” from the third Whereas clause so that the clause reads as follows:

WHEREAS, the Mayor seeks to increase the compensation of certain firefighters, to allow the City to buyback Kelly Days, and to compensate Battalion Chiefs for working extra shifts; and

2. Ordinance 23-13, Section I A shall be amended by deleting the Assistant Chief of Operations position and associated job grade from the list of Fire Department Employees.

**Synopsis**

This amendment is sponsored by Cm. Piedmont-Smith and would remove the proposed Assistant Chief of Operations position in the Fire Department from the ordinance. After discussion with Chief Moore and feedback from firefighters, it was determined that the City should not take on the \$118,000 annual fiscal impact of the additional position at this time.
