Rick Dietz reported on CoB activities:

- CTP Updates (via Jason Carnes):
 - Tuesday we received 13 RFP's for the 10th St and utility realignment project
 - Oct. 8th we will be releasing the RFP for site development. This is the RFP where developers will be making offers to buy parcels and develop the site within the scope of the CTP Masterplan vision.
- IT Policy Manual released yesterday Oct 1. Thanks to members for topical discussions and consultation. No problems with release so far. Onboarding materials will change for new staff to reflect policy changes.
- HR is now on Kuali Time. Now ITS, Controller & HR. Further offices delayed until after new year.
- City budget has been approved with funds for ITS to connect Upper Cascade via fiber, upgrade the Council Chambers audio visual system (control room, cameras, mics, etc), and start GIS transition to ESRI platform.
- Groups in the Netherlands are evaluating our Open311 platform.
