*Topics of discussion*

*Infrastructure Updates*

Rick Routon and Rick Dietz updated members on status of BDU projects on 3<sup>rd</sup> St, B-Line and at Transit: Work complete at 3<sup>rd</sup> St and B-Line. Transit project is pending final facility plans.

*CTP Certified Technology Park*

Danise Alano-Martin, City Director of Economic & Sustainable Development, updated the committee on the progress of the CTP Certified Tech Park. CTP was certified in 2005. City has purchased IU land with intent to subdivide and sell for mixed-use development. Request for Qualifications issued and 10 submissions have been received. 5-6 will be interviewed. The City hopes to begin public process in mid-November. BDUAC will be part of the public process. Danise is happy to talk to BDUAC members anytime.

*eHealth*

Mark McMath reported on IU Health facilities... 3 new buildings connected recently. Dr Mike Sullivan provided updates in Internet2 e-health activities and discussed the Rural Healthcare Pilot project and use cases such as cloud-based medical office suites and medical data backup. US Ignite (a related effort to devise high bandwidth network use cases) was also discussed.

*InCNTRE and SDN*

Matt Davy reported on the startup of InCNTRE, the Indiana Center for Network Translational Research. This new organization is leading research into Software Defined Networking, an effort to commoditize network hardware and unleash a new generation of innovation in network architecture and management.
