- 1. Call to Order/Welcome
  - a. Some members are out today because of illness, but we still have quorum

- 4. Update: Public Art Natalie Almanza, Subcommittee Chair
  - a. At our committee meeting, 5 additional community art grants were awarded from the master plan grant program
  - b. That means that we have allocated \$6000 for community arts grants for the year, leaving \$4000 in the line that Holly will use for other arts projects
  - c. There were 12 applications, which means that the largest portion of those that weren't awarded will receive a note to apply to the project arts grants, to which they are eligible
  - d. Coming up, Holly Christina and Natalie met this month at the Woodlawn Fire Station at 10th and Woodlawn. There is to be renovation to the station, and therefore some 1% for the arts money will come from it in the future. The firemen want to work with us on this public artwork.
  - e. There seems to be some overlap between community art grants and the other grants committee offerings. In the coming months we should look to how we might streamline this process.
- 5. Update: Grants -Elliot Josephine Leila Reichert, Grants Subcommittee Chair
  - a. Leila reports that the call for applications for the artistic advancement grant has been drafted and sent to city legal
  - b. She has sent a description of the grants chair position to members, and willing to answer questions
  - c. Leila will likely be involved in planning the agenda for the upcoming year
- 6. From your Chair Gerard
  - a. The presentation that Holly and Gerard made to city council last week was a success
  - b. This was our strongest year in the past three in terms of grant dollars awarded
