### **Late June Early July Respite for the Common Council (No Meetings Until a Regular Session and Committee of the Whole on July 13<sup>th</sup>)**

The Council will take an unusual respite before it considers the next round of legislation and the departmental budget hearings in July. That respite and revisions to the July schedule are detailed in the attached notices and a briefly summarized below:

- The Council will meet next on July 13<sup>th</sup> when it will start the first legislative cycle in July with a Regular Session immediately followed by a Committee of the Whole;
- The Council will hold Departmental Budget Hearings over four evenings in one week rather than over five evenings in two weeks. Those hearings will run from Monday, July 18<sup>th</sup> – Thursday, July 21<sup>st</sup> and start at 6:00 p.m. (rather than 7:00 p.m.);
- The Council will start the second legislative cycle in July on July 27<sup>th</sup> with a Regular Session immediately followed by a Committee of the Whole. Please note that this Regular Session was rescheduled from July 20<sup>th</sup>.
