Five Items on the Committee of the Whole Agenda Scheduled for Wednesday, December 8, 2004

There are five items for discussion at the Committee of the Whole next Wednesday. They include three ordinances and two related resolutions listed above in the order they appear on the agenda. The legislation and supporting documents can all be found in the packet and supplement for the December 1, 2004 Regular Session.

Amendment to Ord 04-38 (Amending Title 15)

Councilmember Volan intends to introduce an amendment to **Ord 04-38** at the request of the President of Collins Living Learning Center. Currently, the Board of Public Works may allocate as many as 100 Zone 7 permits to residents of the Center. This amendment would allocate up to 80 Zone 7 parking permits for residents of Collins Center and up to 20 Zone 6 parking permits for residents of Hillcrest Apartments, which serves as an annex to the Center. Please note that the east/west boundary between Zone 6 and 7 is 10th Street and that Collins Center is in Zone 7 and Hillcrest Apartments is in Zone 6.

Proposed Amendment:

1. Ordinance 04-38 shall be amended by inserting a new Section XVI and renumber the current and subsequent sections accordingly. The new Section XVI shall read as follows:

SECTION XVI Section 15.37.220 entitled "Collins Center residents" shall be amended to read as follows:

15.37.220 Collins Center residents.

The board of public works may provide up to eighty Zone 7 parking permits annually to residents of the Collins Center dormitory and up to twenty Zone 6 parking permits annually to residents of its Hillcrest Apartment annex. The fee for one of these permits shall be fifteen dollars per year.

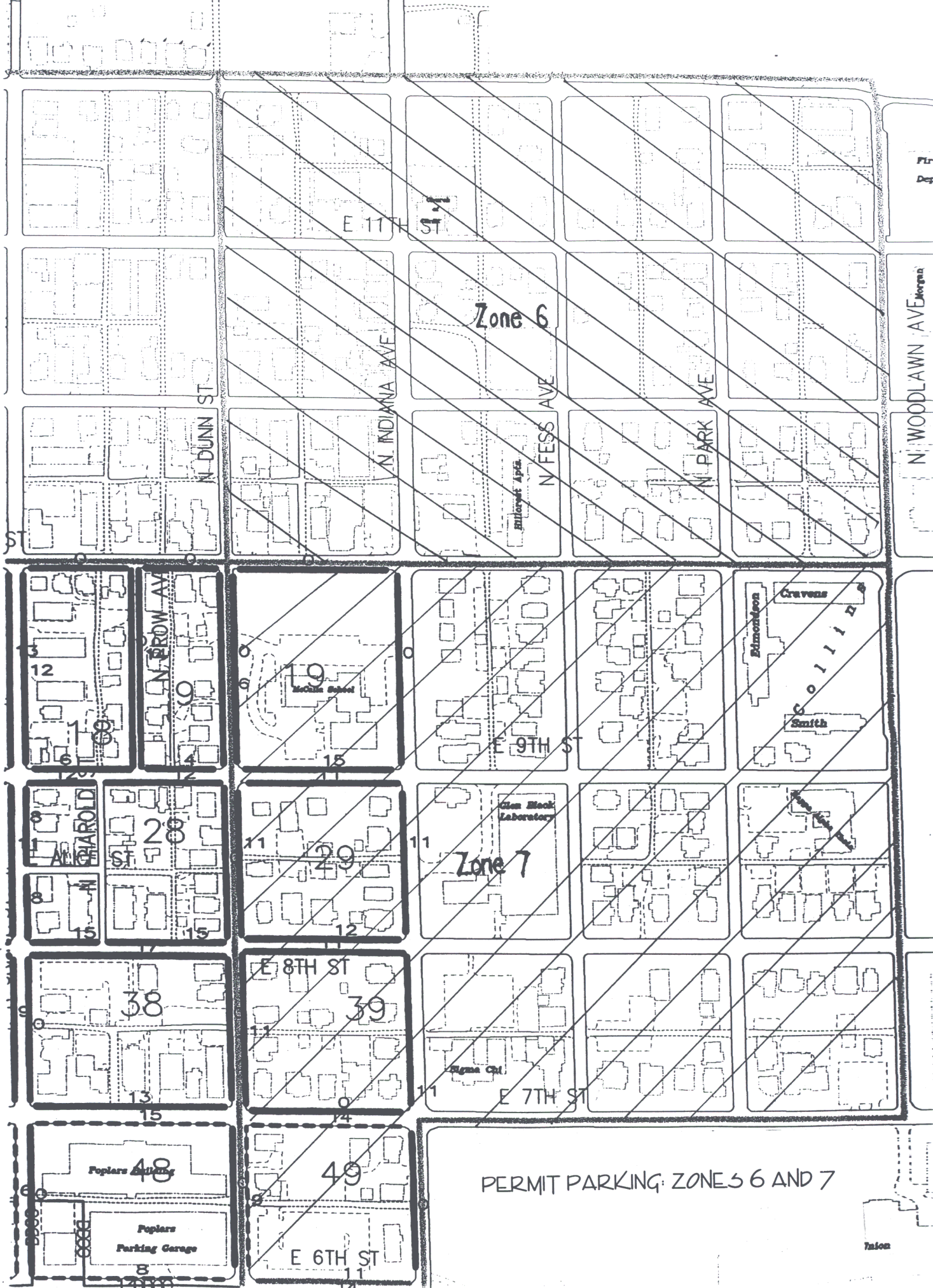
Synopsis

Currently the Board of Public Works may allocate up to 100 of Zone 7 parking permits annually to residents of Collins Center. This amendment would reallocate those 100 permits in the following manner: up to 80 of the permits would be set aside as Zone 7 permits for residents of Collins Center and up to 20 the permits would be set aside as Zone 6 parking permits for residents of the Hillcrest Apartments.
