

NOTE: *While formal minutes are not produced for budget hearings; the following summarizes actions taken at the budget hearings.*

The Common Council met nightly from August 20-23 to discuss the 2019 budget for the City of Bloomington as proposed by Mayor Hamilton. Each department presented their budget for 2019 and received a preliminary vote from the Council. Throughout the remainder of August and September, the administration will work with the Council and various departments to prepare a final version of the 2019 budget for the City of Bloomington. In October, the Common Council hears the budget and makes a final vote. At that time, councilmembers may vote to reduce the budget but may not add to the budget.
