7. Batchelor Middle School Forest removal. Tom reported on his efforts to protest the replacement of the Forest at Batchelor Middle School that was planted by schoolchildren from 1999 – 2010 by a new Monroe County Public Library building complex. Comments ensured. Connect with the people on the County Plan Commission, the MCCSC School Board, and the MCPL Library Board who had not known of the Forest before this plan was prepared. Make allies with the PTA. Create a comprehensive flier or report on the Forest that uses both visual images and statistics to show what was planted, how it has grown, and what it contributes to environmental health in the area so that everyone can have a common source of information. Once these are accomplished the Tree Commission can write a supporting letter. Tom will talk with the Environmental Commission at its May meeting. Tom already has planned to talk with the Editor of the H-T for a Sunday editorial. Talk with WFIU Noon Edition (Bob Zaltzberg) and ask a question at WFIU Ask the Mayor (Joe Wrenn). Create a Facebook page or website (and use other new media) to publicize the issue.
