Murphy announced that he would not be a candidate for the State General Assembly in 1986.

Mayor Allison noted the deaths of three civic leaders this week; Helen Barrett who was associated with Bloomington Hospital; Marvard Clark who worked for the City of Bloomington for almost 50 years; and Tom Lemon, three term Mayor of Bloomington.

Gross moved and Foley seconded the motion that Resolution 86-7 be introduced and read by title only. Clerk Williams read the resolution.

Gross moved and Foley seconded the motion that Resolution 86-7 be adopted. There was no committee report.

Both Gene Stokes and Mayor Allison praised the selfsufficency program as the best kind of assistance for our fellow citizens.

Service noted that this seemed to be the very type of program that the federal administration is trying to eliminate.
