ROLL CALL

Council President Dilcher gave the agenda summation.

AGENDA SUMMATION

Service said that it promised to be an interesting New Year with the newly elected Mayor Tomilea Allison. While it is an election year we can have an atmosphere that is positive and still fresh.

MESSAGES FROM COUNCIL-
MEMBERS

Murphy commented on some of the difficult aspects of political life and the ever present struggle to maintain a sensitivity to people, issues, and principles.

Olcott congratulated newly elected Mayor Tomi Allison.

Hogan said that he agreed with everything councilmember Murphy addressed and also congratulated the new Mayor.

Mayor Allison said that she was looking forward to the next five years. Working with the Council will be interesting and with her experience on the council, she is looking forward to a very harmonious relationship.

Murphy moved and Towell seconded a motion that Pam Service be appointed to the Plan Commission.

Olcott nominated Steve Hogan.

Murphy nominated John Porter

Olcott nominated Al Towell.

Porter and Towell declined the nominations.

Service was elected by a roll call vote of Ayes: 5 Nays: 3. (Morrison, Porter, Olcott). Mr. Hogan graciously voted for Service thereby electing Service to the Plan Commission.

Olcott moved and Morrison seconded a motion to introduce and read Ordinance 82-82 by title only.

Clerk Williams read the ordinance by title only.

Olcott moved and Morrison seconded a motion to adopt Ordinance 82-82. Dilcher read the legislative synopsis.

Steve Wajda presented a summary of the space situation at the Rosehill Cemetery. Seventy-five (75) lots were utilized this year with 552 remaining.

Hogan asked what comparable fees would be at Valhalla Memory Gardens. Wajda said from \$225 to \$600 depending on site location.

Porter asked about an endowment supporting Rose Hill. Wajda said that there is a Rosehill Trust in which only the interest is allowed to be used. The operation of the cemetery is budgeted for about \$50,000 with the fees bringing in about \$ 25,000.

The ordinance received a roll call vote of Ayes: 8, Nays: 0.

Olcott moved and Morrison seconded a motion to introduce and read for First Reading the following ordinances. Clerk Williams read the ordinances by title only.
