ORDINANCE 82-36.  
TO AMEND CHAPTERS  
20.04, 20.07, 20.08,  
and 20.19 OF THE  
BLOOMINGTON MUNICIPAL  
CODE (MANUFACTURED  
HOUSING)

Clerk Williams read the ordinance by title only.

Olcott moved and Morrison seconded a motion to adopt Ordinance 82-36.

The following amendment was proposed by the Plan Commission:

Section VII of the ordinance is amended to add the following to Subsection 20.08.01.00 (a):

- (a) Siding Materials. Siding materials used on residential dwelling units shall consist of any of the following: horizontal lap siding; V-Grooved tongue and groove siding; woodgrained vertical siding materials in a board and batten or reverse batten pattern; cedar or other wood shakes; stucco; masonry or glass. Siding materials permitted above, or a combination of such siding materials, shall extend from roofline to grade and completely enclose all underfloor space.

The amendment received a roll call vote of Ayes: 9, Nays: 0.

The ordinance as amended received a roll call vote of Ayes: 9, Nays: 0.




