Porter asked when this grant would used. Martindale said the last six months of the year (1982).

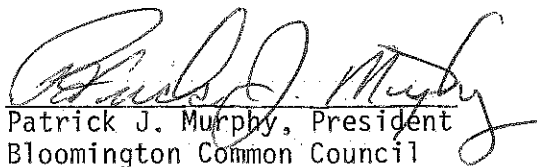
The resolution received a roll call vote of Ayes: 9, Nays: 0.

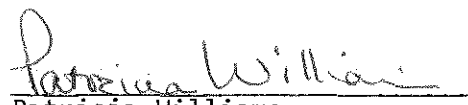
