MESSAGE FROM THE MAYOR

Councilman Fix announced that the
"Oregon Ban-the -Bottle" legislation
was coming up and what it was about.

MESSAGES FROM COUNCILMEMBERS

Councilman Towell announced a public
hearing on landlord - tenate. He said
this could use support and that it
will be in the state house.

Councilman Towell then expressed his
concern on the confusion of points
regarding the emergency food and fuel
situation. Stating that at a meeting
in December of the County-City Councils
he was reassured that things are coming
along fine. He then read a letter from
Mike Corbit that stated donations were
greatly appreciated since situations
were bad. He didn't understand the two
completely conflicting statements.
Another bothering problem is that no one
has stated how the figure of \$25,000 was
arrived at. Exactly how did they arrive
at this figure being enough or not enough.

Council President then explained the new
Council reorganization and how it would
work. He thanked Al Towell and the
Councilmembers for their help and efforts
put forth in getting this organized. He
also thanked Marsha Kmack for doing such
a good job on the charts he was using to
make his explanation.

Councilman Behen then spoke on the importance
of department heads to look ahead in regard
to getting budget transfers on the agenda
early enough to get them passed when wanted.

Councilwoman Zietlow moved Appropriation
Ordinance 75-1 be introduced and read
by the clerk by title only. The motion
carried by unanimous voice vote of the
council.

Councilwoman Zietlow moved 75-1
be adopted. Councilwoman Davis
seconded the motion.

Mr. Wilson explained the appropriation
ordinance request, stating that this
was a re-appropriation as stated in
the letter the council had. He stated
this had to be done because for some
reason the state held up acting on the
appropriation in 1974.


Councilman Fix asked for the amount of
