

COUNCIL MEETING OF DECEMBER 14, 1971, FOLLOWING THE PUBLIC HEARING OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF REDEVELOPMENT.

Attending: Jack Morrison, Clyde Day, Robert Clegg, Robert Gray, James Clendening, Harry Day, Richard Fee, Charles Faris.

Others DANNY J. FULTON, JACK HOOKER, W. LINDER at side table.

Robert Gray called Common Council meeting to order at 9:20 p.m. Councilman Johnson had a previous meeting and could not be at this meeting.

Clyde Day gave the invocation.

It was announced that this was a special meeting of the Common Council in order that the Common Council could act on RESOLUTION 71-34, concerning the NDP application.

Charles Faris asked that RESOLUTION 71-34 be read, seconded, motion carried.

GLADYS VAN HOOK read RESOLUTION 71-34 (page 1 and page 2 to "1" on page 2.) Jack Hooker read the rest of the RESOLUTION.

Richard Fee questioned the fact that the RESOLUTION states that 16 pages and 2 exhibits, etc. presented to the Councilmen--He has not received a copy.

LINDER said he had them.

R. Fee stated he had not reviewed them. R. Fee was given copies of all the papers--NDP application, Resolution. Fee stated he appreciated a bale of paper, which he will forward to his successor.

Clyde Day wished to state publicly that he has mixed emotions about the Resolution. He wants to go on record as saying he is undecided.

Harry Day stated he had attended discussions regarding this, and has high regard for the Redevelopment Commission, and the Director, and he takes some things on faith. All his personal contacts show the areas need the support called for in the Resolution.

Richard Fee stated his comments were not intended as a lack of confidence or to be negative--just intended to point out the facts.

Clyde Day stated nothing is free in this world, and he hoped the City would get some of the federal tax back.

The President called for questions.

Bill Lloyd stated on behalf of the West side Pac Committee he requested the Council seek the funds for the NDP project. The West Side has faith in Mr. Fulton and Mr. Linder and their program. To that extent that the citizens can participate he seeks, on behalf of the West Side PAC Committee the approval of the necessary documents.

Mr. Everett Harding said that the Miller Drive area cannot express any more on the need in the Miller Drive area--Miller Drive area has no other choice as people cannot raise the 50% of funds needed on other programs.

Mr. Gray stated that question has been called for.

Jack Hooker stated that this Administration goes on record as supporting this NDP application. Mr. Hooker requested and asked for the Council to vote favorably.

Charles Faris moved for the adoption of RESOLUTION 71-34.
