Area Subject to Jurisdiction
of Bloomington Zoning Ord.

Councilman Clegg moved to suspend rules and to advance proposed Ordinance No. 70-50 to second reading and to be read by title only. Councilman Faris seconded the motion.

Councilman Clegg moved to amend Ordinance No. 70-50 as follows: That in Section 6b, the words, "carried on upon the site of such signs", be stricken out. Motion seconded by Councilman Clendening.

Mr. Frank Barnhart, attorney recommended that the amendment be amended so that Section 6 and 8 would have same wording in regard to zones.

Councilman Clegg moved to amend the amendment as follows: Section 6. No signs shall be erected or installed in any B-1 Zone except on premise signs.

No signs may be erected or installed in any B-2 or B-3 zone except the following:

6b. Signs pertaining to business or commercial enterprises subject to the following limitations:

REPORTS FROM CITY OFFICIALS

Emphasis focused on State Government in relation to Federal and local government. Also emphasized were Water and Air pollution.

MESSAGES FROM COUNCILMEN

Mr. James Cotner, City Attorney, was late for meeting due to Court appearance out of town and therefore was not present at the time the Council amended and adopted proposed Ordinance No. 70-50, as to regulating signs within area subject to jurisdiction of the City of Bloomington. Councilman Fee advised him of the action taken. Mr. Cotner stated they would have to send the already enacted ordinance back to the plan commission for action because the new amendments had not been before the Commission. After considerable discussion between Mr. Cotner, Mr. Barnhart and the Council, Mr. Barnhart proposed that Council transmit a Resolution to Plan Commission ratifying Council's action.
