Mr. Cotner, City Attorney stated that Mr. Frank Barnhart, attorney, has proposed by letter that a restriction be placed in the contract and deed, restricting use of property to professional offices or such use as shall be made by new zoning ordinance master plan when completed.

Mr. Barnhart stated a three year restriction would be placed in the deed to the land assuring it would be used only for professional businesses. The restriction would be in force less than three years if a new zoning ordinance is passed.
