Councilman Fee moved that proposed Salary Ordinance No. 69-1 be introduced and read by the Clerk. Motion seconded by Councilman Johnson and carried.

ORDINANCES GENERAL

The Clerk read proposed Salary Ordinance No. 69-1 in its entirety.
