Councilman Fee moved that the minutes of the October 17, 1968 meeting be approved as xeroxed and distributed. Councilman Day seconded the motion and it carried.

Amendment to Traffic Ordinance

The Clerk read proposed Ordinance No. 68-63 by title only.

Councilman Clegg moved that proposed Ordinance No. 68-63 be amended by inserting the word "North" in Section 1, line 5, to make that portion of Section 1 read as follows:

"East side of South Rogers Street from West Second Street North to the first East-West alley."

Councilman Day asked if each proposed ordinance could be explained briefly before the final vote is taken. He said this would be beneficial to the visiting Indiana University students who are in Urban Government classes.

Council President Faris said Mr. Hooker was absent from the meeting tonight attending the Metropolitan School Board meeting.


MESSAGES FROM MAYOR






