## RESOLUTION NO. 64-1

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON  
COUNTY OF MONROE, STATE OF INDIANA

WHEREAS, Common Council of the City of Bloomington is entitled to adopt rules and regulations for the conduct of its business and

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Bloomington by Ordinance No. 7, 1954, Section 1 and amendments thereto have by ordinance adopted rules for the conduct of the Common Council;

NOW THEREFORE, Be it resolved that the Common Council of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, adopt and ratify the rules heretofore established by Ordinance No. 7, 1954, Section 1, and the amendments thereto as found in Chapter 2 of the Municipal Code of the City of Bloomington, Indiana, 1957, until such time as such rules and regulations may be reviewed by the committee upon Rules, Ordinances, and Resolutions and proposed amendments thereto be submitted by such committee and considered by this Council.
