STATUTORY MEETING

Councilman Fee presented Appropriation Ordinance 3, 1964, for first reading by the Clerk-Treasurer.

The Clerk-Treasurer read Appropriation Ordinance 3, 1964.

Councilman Derge moved, seconded by Councilman Johnson, that rules be suspended and Appropriation Ordinance 3, 1964, be advanced to second reading. Upon a roll call vote, the motion was carried unanimously.

Councilman Fee moved, seconded by Councilman Faris, that Appropriation Ordinance 3, 1964, be advanced to second reading and read by title only. Upon a roll call vote, the motion was carried unanimously.

The Clerk-Treasurer read by title only, Appropriation Ordinance 3, 1964.

Councilman Fee moved, seconded by Councilman Faris, that the following amendments be made to the Park & Recreation Budget and to the Rosehill Cemetery Budget.

Park & Recreation -- Item 213 reduced from \$1,615 to \$600 Item 264 reduced from \$18,690 to \$11,690 Item 55 reduced from \$175 to \$50

Rosehill Cemetery -- Item 42 reduced from \$9,500 to \$500

Upon a roll call vote, the motion was carried unanimously.

Councilman Faris moved, seconded by Councilman Moulden, that Appropriation Ordinance 3, 1964, be duly adopted. Upon a roll call vote, the motion was carried unanimously.

Mayor Hooker stated that we did not have more than six to twelve taxpayers at any one time represented this evening for the Special Meeting of the Common Council for the 1965 Budget for the operation of the City of Bloomington.

Councilman Johnson moved, seconded by Councilman Moulden, that the meeting be adjourned. Motion carried unanimously.
