

REGULAR MEETING

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA, met in the Council Chambers in City Hall on Tuesday June 4, 1963, at the hour of seven-thirty o'clock (7:30 P. M.) in regular session with the Mayor presiding.

Members Present: Chitwood, Pearson, Faucett, Hickman and Shertzer,
Sikes.

Members Absent: Peace

The meeting was opened with a prayer by Rev. Wm. Eddy, Minister of the Episcopal Church.

Councilman Sikes moved, seconded by Councilman Chitwood, that the minutes of the regular meeting of May 21, 1963 be approved; motion unanimously carried.

Mr. Sylvan Tackitt, Attorney, presented a suit for various alley vacations for Indiana University which was being filed in Monroe Circuit Court. Mr. Tackitt asked that the Council not oppose the suit.

Councilman Hickman moved, seconded by Councilman Faucett, that the City Attorney be instructed to not oppose the suit in Monroe Circuit Court for various alley vacations for Indiana University in the area north of East Third Street and west of Union Street; motion unanimously carried.

Councilman Sikes presented Ordinance Number 19, 1963, for first reading by the Clerk-Treasurer.

The Clerk-Treasurer read Ordinance Number 19, 1963.

Councilman Sikes presented Resolution Number 15, 1963, for reading by the Clerk-Treasurer.

RESOLUTION # 15, 1963

WHEREAS, a full time County Health Department is recognized as a more practical way of assuring health protection to the citizens of Monroe County, and

WHEREAS, such a full time department could offer a more comprehensive health protection to the residents through services rendered by professional and trained staff, and

WHEREAS, the establishment of a full time County Health Department is endorsed by the Indiana State Board of Health, Indiana State Medical Association, American Medical Association, Monroe County Medical Society, and other health agencies;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Common Council of the City of Bloomington, Indiana approves the establishment of a full time County Health Department, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Common Council recommend that the County Commissioners take necessary action to establish and maintain a health department.

Councilman Chitwood moved, seconded by Councilman Faucett, that claims presented for payment June 5, 1963 be allowed; motion unanimously carried.
