

February 20, 1962

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA, met in the Council Chambers in City Hall, on Tuesday, February 20, 1962, at the hour of seven-thirty o'clock (7:30 P.M.) in regular session with Mayor Thos. L. Lemon presiding.

Members present: Chitwood, Peace, Graves, Faucett, Hickman, and Shertzer.

Members absent: Sikes.

The meeting was opened with a prayer by Councilman Graves.

Mayor Lemon welcomed the Boy Scouts to Council meeting and introduced the Scouts representing the Common Council in honor of Boy Scout Week.

Councilman Peace moved, seconded by Councilman Graves that the minutes of the last regular meeting of February 6, 1962 be approved as submitted to each individual councilman; motion unanimously carried.

Councilman Peace presented Ordinance No. 5, 1962 pertaining to the licensing of bicycles for second reading. After second reading by the Clerk-Treasurer, Councilman Graves moved, seconded by Councilman Chitwood that Ordinance No. 5, 1962 be duly adopted. After a public hearing on Ordinance No. 5, 1962, a roll call vote was held with Ordinance No. 5, 1962 being unanimously approved.

Councilman Peace presented Ordinance No. 6, 1962 for first reading by the Clerk-Treasurer.

Councilman Peace presented the following Resolution No. 2 of the Plan Commission:

RESOLUTION NO. 2, 1962

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY PLAN COMMISSION OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA, RELATING TO THE RENAMING OF A CITY STREET.

WHEREAS, Bankers Growth Corporation of Indianapolis, Indiana, is the present owner of Blue Ridge Estates, a subdivision of the City of Bloomington, Monroe County, Indiana, and

WHEREAS, Said Bankers Growth Corporation has requested that certain street names as shown on the recorded plat of said subdivision be changed, now

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY PLAN COMMISSION OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION 1. The City Plan Commission recommend to the Bloomington Common Council that the following changes be made in the street names of Blue Ridge Estates, to-wit:

- (a) Change Ramble Road West to Bankers Drive.
- (b) Change Ramble Road East to Ramble Road.
- (c) Change Drane Drive to Blue Ridge Drive.

Councilman Graves moved, seconded by Councilman Peace that Plan Commission Resolution No. 2, 1962 be approved as submitted and the street names be changed accordingly; motion unanimously carried.

Attorney Ferguson presented a petition for voluntary annexation in behalf of his clients, Edward Krulewitch and William J. Nasser. Councilman Hickman moved, seconded by Councilman Faucett that the annexation petition be referred to the City Attorney for report at next meeting; motion unanimously carried.

Attorney Ferguson requested the Council not to oppose a suit in Circuit Court to vacate an alley between Madison and Morton south of Allen Street. Councilman Hickman moved, seconded by Councilman Graves that this petition be referred to the City Building and Property Committee for study and report at next meeting; motion unanimously carried.

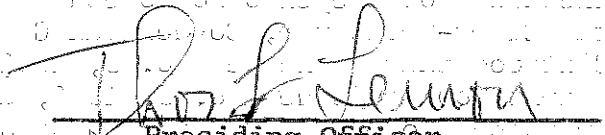
Councilman Peace reported that the City Building and Property Committee had investigated a petition to vacate an alley between Dunn and Indiana Avenue north of 12th Street. Councilman Peace moved, seconded by Councilman Hickman that the City Attorney be instructed not to oppose suit in Circuit Court to vacate said alley; motion unanimously carried.

Monthly reports for January, 1962, were received from the Water Department and Police Department, and placed on file.

Monthly reports for December, 1961, and January, 1962, were received from the Park and Recreation Department and placed on file.

Councilman Chitwood moved, seconded by Councilman Graves that the claims presented for payment February 21, 1962 be allowed as submitted; motion unanimously carried.
