THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA, met in the Board of public Works and Safety room in City Hall, on Tuesday, May 1, 1962, at the hour of ten-thirty o'clock (10:30 P.M.) in special session.

Members present: Sikes, Chitwood, Peace, Graves, Hickman, and Shertzer.

Members absent: Faucett.

Special meeting was held by the Common Council pursuant to a notice previously given to all members of the Council for the purpose of designating a Mayor Pro-Tem and issuing notice for an election of Mayor according to law.

Councilman Hickman moved, seconded by Councilman Graves that Councilman Sikes be nominated as presiding officer. Councilman Peace moved the nominations be closed. Upon a roll call vote the motion was unanimously carried and Councilman Sikes was elected presiding officer.


