Councilmand Peace moved, seconded by Councilman Faucett that the minutes of the last regular meeting September 19, 1961 and special meeting September 28, 1961 be a pproved as submitted to each individual Councilman; motion carried.

Councilman Sikes moved, seconded by Councilman Chitwood that Ordinance No. 24, 1961 be advaned to second reading by title only. Upon roll call vote, motion unanimously carried. Councilman Beace moved, seconded by Councilman Faucett that Ordinance No. 24, 1961 be duly adopted. Councilman Sikes, moved, seconded by Councilman Peace that Ordinance No. 24 be amended by striking out Section 3 and renumbering Section 4 to become Section 3 and striking out that part of the title following "zone" in the fourth line of the title; motion unanimously carried. Councilman Peace moved, seconded by Councilman FAucett that the original motion to adopt Ordinance No. 24 be amended to include the amendment and that Ordinance No. 24, 1961 be duly adopted as amended. Upon roll call vote, motion unanimously carried.

Councilman Sikes presented Ordinances No. 26, 1961, No. 27, 1961 and No. 28, 1961 for first reading by the Clerk Treasurer.

Dr. Ramsey was recognized by the Chair and spoke against Brban Renewal.

Reports from the Sanitation Department, Rosehill Cemetery, Street Department, Sanitarian Officer, Humane Officer for the month of September and Police Department for the month of August were received and placed on file.'

Councilman Chitwood and Councilman Peace moved that the claims presented for payment October 4, 1961 be approved as submitted.
