

REGULAR MEETING

May 3, 1960

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA, met in the Council Chambers in City Hall, on Tuesday, May 3, 1960, at the hour of seven-thirty o'clock (7:30 P.M. D.S.T.) in regular session with Mayor Thos. L. Lemon presiding.

Members present: Sikes, Peace, Graves, Faucett, Stikeleather, and Marxson.

Members absent: Chitwood.

The meeting was opened with a prayer by Councilman Graves.

Councilman Graves moved, seconded by Councilman Peace that the minutes of the last regular meeting of April 19, 1960 be approved as submitted to each individual councilman; motion unanimously carried.

Councilman Sikes presented Ordinance No. 13, 1960 for second reading by the Clerk-Treasurer. Councilman Graves moved, seconded by Councilman Sikes that Ordinance No. 13, 1960 be duly adopted. Upon a roll call vote Ordinance No. 13, 1960 was unanimously adopted.

Councilman Sikes moved, seconded by Councilman Peace that Ordinance No. 14, 1960 be advanced to second reading by title only. Upon a roll call vote ~~none~~ the motion was unanimously carried. After second reading by title only, Councilman Stikeleather moved, seconded by Councilman Marxson that Ordinance No. 14, 1960 be duly adopted. Upon a roll call vote Ordinance No. 14, 1960 was unanimously adopted.

Councilman Sikes moved, seconded by Councilman Peace that Ordinance No. 15, 1960 be advanced to second reading by title only. Upon a roll call vote the motion was unanimously carried. Councilman Peace moved, seconded by Councilman Graves that Ordinance No. 15, 1960 be duly adopted. Upon a roll call vote Ordinance No. 15, 1960 was adopted with Councilman Stikeleather dissenting. The motion was carried.

Reports for the month of April, 1960, were received from the Plumbing Inspector, Sanitation Department, and Street Department and placed on file.

Councilman Graves moved, seconded by Councilman Peace that the claims presented for payment May 4, 1960 be allowed as submitted; motion unanimously carried.
