## BLOOMINGTON TRAFFIC COMMISSION

TO; The Mayor and the Common Council of Bloomington, Indiana:

At the October 11, 1960 meeting of the Bloomington Traffic Commission, below listed traffic and related recommendations were adopted and are herewith submitted to the Mayor and the Common Council for consideration and action:

- 1. Recommends that no parking be allowed on Dodds Street from Rogers to Morton on the north side....that the south side be designated no parking from Rogers Street to the end of the Stewart grocery with a loading zone to the east of the no parking area.\*\*..that the south side of Dodds be designated no parking from Rogers to Morton 11 A.M. to 1 P.M. and 4 P.M. to 6 P.M. Monday thru Friday with this stipulation also including the loading zone area.
- 2. Recommends that one parking space be eliminated on the east side of Rogers street north of Second Street.
- 3. Recommends that three parking spaces south of the east-west alley in front of the Coca Cola plant on South Washington be designated 30-minute parking.
