

SPECIAL MEETING

September 21, 1959

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA, met in the Council Chambers in City Hall, on Monday, September 21, 1959, at the hour of eleven-thirty o'clock (11:30 A.M. D.S.T.) in special session with Mayor Thos. L. Lemon presiding.

Members absent: None.

Special meeting called to fill a vacancy created by the death of Councilman Griffith, according to section 283.

Councilman Van Meter nominated Mrs. Gladys Woodward.

Councilman Chitwood nominated Dr. Donald E. Stikeleather.

Councilman Van Meter moved, seconded by Councilman Miller that the nominations be closed; motion unanimously carried.

Councilman Miller moved, seconded by Councilman Chitwood that there being no further business at this time the Council adjourn; motion unanimously carried.
