

30 September 1958

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA, met in the Council Chambers in City Hall, on Tuesday, September 16, 1958, at the hour of seven-thirty o'clock (7:30 P.M. I.S.T.) in regular session with Mayor Wm. A. Lemon presiding.

Members present: Graves, Whitwood, Griffith, Sikes, Miller, Simpson, and Van Meter.

Members absent: None.

The meeting was opened with a prayer by Councilman Graves.

Councilman Graves, moved, seconded by Councilman Whitwood that the minutes of the last regular meeting of September 2nd be approved as submitted to each individual councilman; motion unanimously carried.

Councilman Sikes presented Ordinance No. 24, 1958 for second reading by the Clerk-Treasurer. After second reading by the Clerk-Treasurer, Councilman Whitwood moved, seconded by Councilman Simpson that Ordinance No. 24, 1958 be duly adopted. Upon a roll call vote Ordinance No. 24, 1958 was unanimously adopted.

Councilman Sikes presented Ordinance No. 25, 1958 for first reading by the Clerk-Treasurer. After first reading by the Clerk-Treasurer, Councilman Miller moved, seconded by Councilman Simpson that Ordinance No. 25, 1958 be advanced to second reading by title only. Upon a roll call vote the motion was unanimously carried.

After second reading by title only, Councilman Graves moved, seconded by Councilman Simpson that Ordinance No. 25, 1958 be duly adopted. Upon a roll call vote Ordinance No. 25, 1958 was unanimously adopted.

The Clerk-Treasurer presented a petition from Leon Stidd, 1117 North College to widen a driveway from eight feet to twenty feet. Councilman Simpson moved, seconded by Councilman Van Meter that the petition be referred to the Council's Public Works Committee to investigate with power to act and the work to be done under the supervision of the City Engineer and the State Highway Department; motion unanimously carried.

Councilman Simpson presented an oral petition in behalf of Beatrice Henderson, 508 South Maple, to cut a driveway into the property. Councilman Simpson moved, seconded by Councilman Miller the petitioner be permitted to cut the curb at 508 South Maple and the work to be done under the supervision of the City Engineer; motion unanimously carried.

The following Traffic Commission recommendations were received:

BLOOMINGTON TRAFFIC COMMISSION

TO: THE CLERK AND COMMON COUNCIL OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA

At the September meeting of the Bloomington Traffic Commission, below listed traffic and related recommendations were adopted and are herewith submitted to the Mayor and the Common Council for consideration and action.

1. A motion was passed that the newly constructed extension of east First Street from Anita Street to High Street be constructed to a width of 30 feet.
2. A recommendation was approved to widen First Street from Sheridan Street to Anita Street to coincide with the extending of First Street from Anita to High Street.
3. A motion was passed that 30-minute parking be established at 521 and 525 North Walnut Street.

Councilman Chitwood moved, seconded by Councilman Graves that the claims presented for payment September 17, 1958 be allowed as submitted; motion unanimously carried.
