THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA, met in the Council Chambers of the City Hall, on Tuesday, November 4, 1958, at the hour of seven-thirty o'clock (7:30 P.M. C.S.T.) in regular session with Mayor Thos. L. Lemon presiding.

The meeting was opened with a prayer by Rev. Richard Hittle of the Clear Creek Christian Church.

Councilman Graves moved, seconded by Councilman <sup>S</sup>impson that the minutes of the last regular meeting of October 21, 1958 be approved as submitted to each individual councilman; motion unanimously carried.

Councilman Simpson presented a petition from Crit H. Blair, 1110 North College to cut the curb for a driveway and moved, seconded by Councilman Van <sup>M</sup>eter that <sup>M</sup>r. Blair be given permission to cut this curb under the supervision of the City Engineeer and upon approval from the State Highway Commission; motion unanimously carried.

James Regester, Attorney for Church Lane Water Line Company, Inc., presented a petition for water service by constructing a 12 inch cast iron water main running from Beck's Crossing to a point immediately opposite of the Clear Creek Christian Church and a 6 inch cast iron water main which would run north from the 12 inch water main to 1800 feet into Shields Addition and beyond. Councilman Sikes moved, seconded by Councilman Griffith that the Board of Public Works and Safety's action with reference to the Church Lane Water Line Company, Inc., be approved in principle and the City Attorney be authorized to prepare a contract and present to the next Council meeting; motion unanimously carried.

Councilman Van Meter moved, seconded by Councilman Simpson that the correspondence from the Civil Aeronautics Board be referred to the President of the local Aviation Board for their attention; motion unanimously carried.

The monthly reports of the Fire Department and the Plumbing Inspector were received and placed on file.

Councilman Graves moved, seconded by Councilman Simpson that the claims presented for payment November 5, 1958 be approved as submitted; motion unanimously carried.
