THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA, met in the Council Chambers in City Hall, on Tuesday, April 2, 1957, at the hour of seven o'clock (7:00 P.M. C.S.T.) in special session, with Mayor Thos. L. Lemon presiding.
