THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON, INDIANA, met in the Council Chamber in City Hall, on Tuesday, October 16, 1956, at the hour of Seven-thirty o'clock (7:30 P.M. DST) in regular session.

Members present: Cook, Miller, Van Meter, Simpson, Engelman, Chitwood and Sikes.

Members absent: None

The meeting was opened by Mary Alice Dunlap, Clerk Treasurer who asked for nominations from the floor for a Presiding Officer in the absence of Mayor Thomas L. Lemon. On motion of Councilman Engelman and seconded by Councilman Van Meter that Councilman Sikes be appointed Chairman of Council Meeting in the absence of the Mayor. Councilman Chitwood moved that the nominations be closed, seconded by Councilman Simpson; motion unanimously carried.

Councilman Engelmanmoved that the Council dispense with reading of the minutes. Seconded by Councilman Chitwood; unanimously carried.

Dr. Szatkowski requested information from the Council as to the annexation of the Northwest section of Forrest Homes Addition that is now on petition to be annexed. His request was pertaining to the boundaries of the annexation and where the people lived that had signed the petition. The Chairman asked Mr. Clark to give him the desired information and that any further remonstrances could be brought before the Council when the annexation was presented.

Councilman Engelman presented an Ordinance on Pine Crest annexation and it was given first reading by the Clerk-Treasurer.

Councilman Engelman moved and seconded by Councilman Miller that the Common Council go on record of resolving that duck hunting be permitted on Bean Blossom from October 20th to the close of the 1956 duck season and that the Board of Public Works and Safety be instructed to prepare the necessary procedures to implement this resolution, and that all guns be limited to shot guns with no slugs; on roll call vote, motion unanimously carried.

Councilman Cook, moved and seconded by Councilman Chitwood that the petition for a street light at the corner of Henderson and Southern Drive be referred to the Street Light Committee; unanimously carried.

Councilman Cook moved and seconded by Councilman Chitwood that the recommendation of the Traffic Commission be referred to the Traffic Committee for further study; unanimously carried.

Councilman Cook moved and seconded by Councilman Chitwood that the claims be allowed; unanimously carried.
